WELCOMING TODAY'S SPEAKER

It is a privilege for me to welcome Revd. Richard Bewes to our church today! Having preached in our church on two previous occasions, Rev. Bewes is no stranger to Loma Linda. We are so pleased to have him back! While here in southern California, Revd. Bewes will also be presenting a workshop to the pastors of the Southeastern California Conference titled "The Romance of Preaching."

As the son of missionary parents, he was born and raised on the lower slopes of Mount Kenya, along with his two brothers and a sister. He describes it as "the most tranquil upbringing a child could have had." He traveled to England for his secondary education before going to Cambridge University as an undergraduate. He then went on to study for the pastoral ministry at Ridley Hall Theological College, Cambridge.

Revd. Bewes comes from a family whose gospel preaching tradition began with D. L. Moody's sermon of September 26th, 1882, when his grandfather, 14-year-old Tommy, made his response and later became a preacher himself. Beginning his ordained ministry in Beckenham, Kent, Revd. Bewes went on to lead churches in Harold Wood and Northwood, prior to his leadership at All Souls. Following his retirement as Rector of All Souls in November 2004 Revd. Bewes was awarded an OBE (Officer of the Most

Excellent Order of the British Empire) in Her Majesty the Queen's 2005 New Year Honours' List for services to the Church of England.

Revd. Bewes' speaking engagements have taken him to Europe, Australia, Africa, the USA, and Canada. He has written over twenty books. He is also known for his hymnwriting and his regular contributions on Christian radio and television—including his co-hosting with the Revd. Dr. Paul Blackham of the "Open Home: Open Bible" and "Book by Book" on-screen Bible study series.

Close to his heart are mission and outreach. For many years, he has been UK chairman of African Enterprise. He has also been a keen supporter of the ministry of the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association, including serving as Chairman of "Mission '89," held in London, England, with Dr. Billy Graham. Revd. Bewes was honored to accept an invitation to join the board of Gospelcom International in 2004, as its very first international board member. (I am indebted to biblicalframeworks.com for much of this material).

Revd. Bewes, we welcome you and your dear wife Pam to our church today and look forward to your ministry of the Word of God to us today!

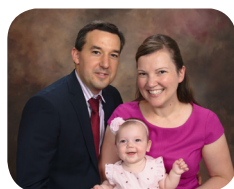
