

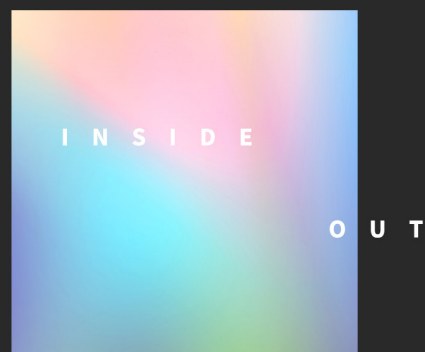

SERMON INTRODUCTION
